Protecting the life in the soil which can die from overheating.

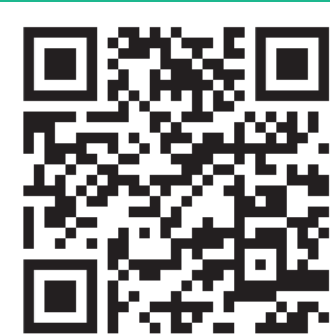
Mulch makes healthy soils
